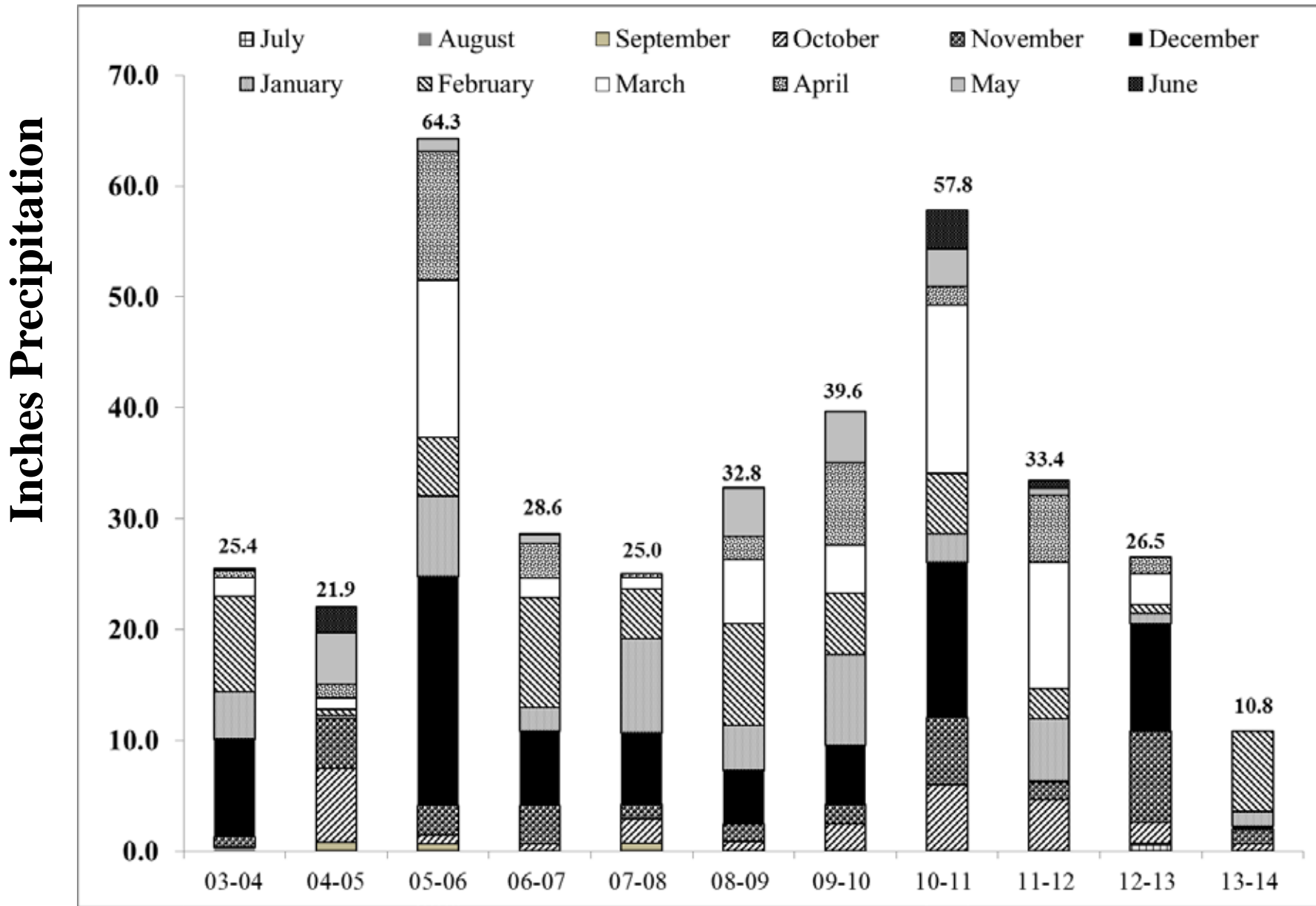

Ten years of precipitation recorded at Camino CIMIS (#13) seasonally, July-June. Updated Feb. 10, 2014.



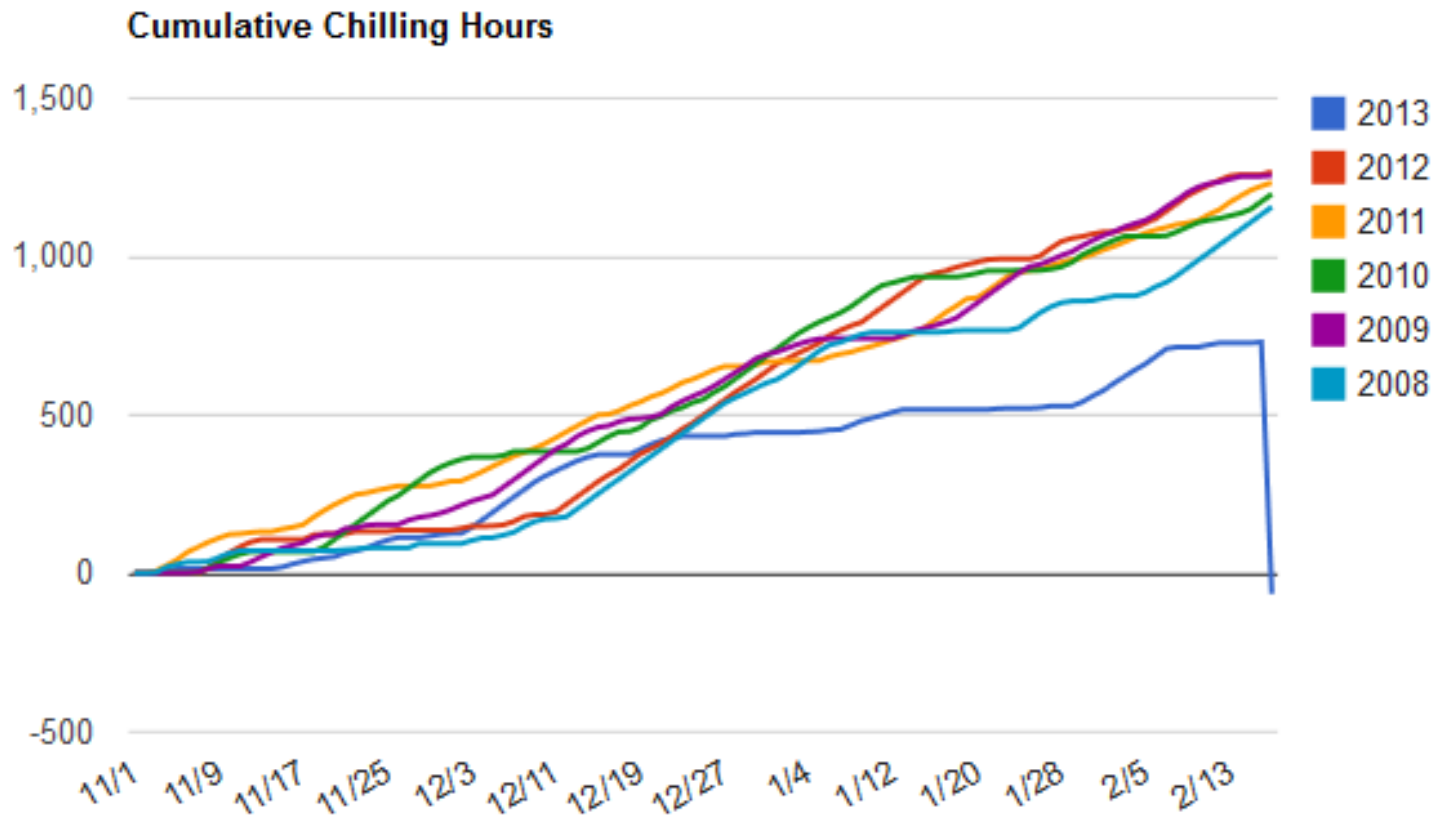

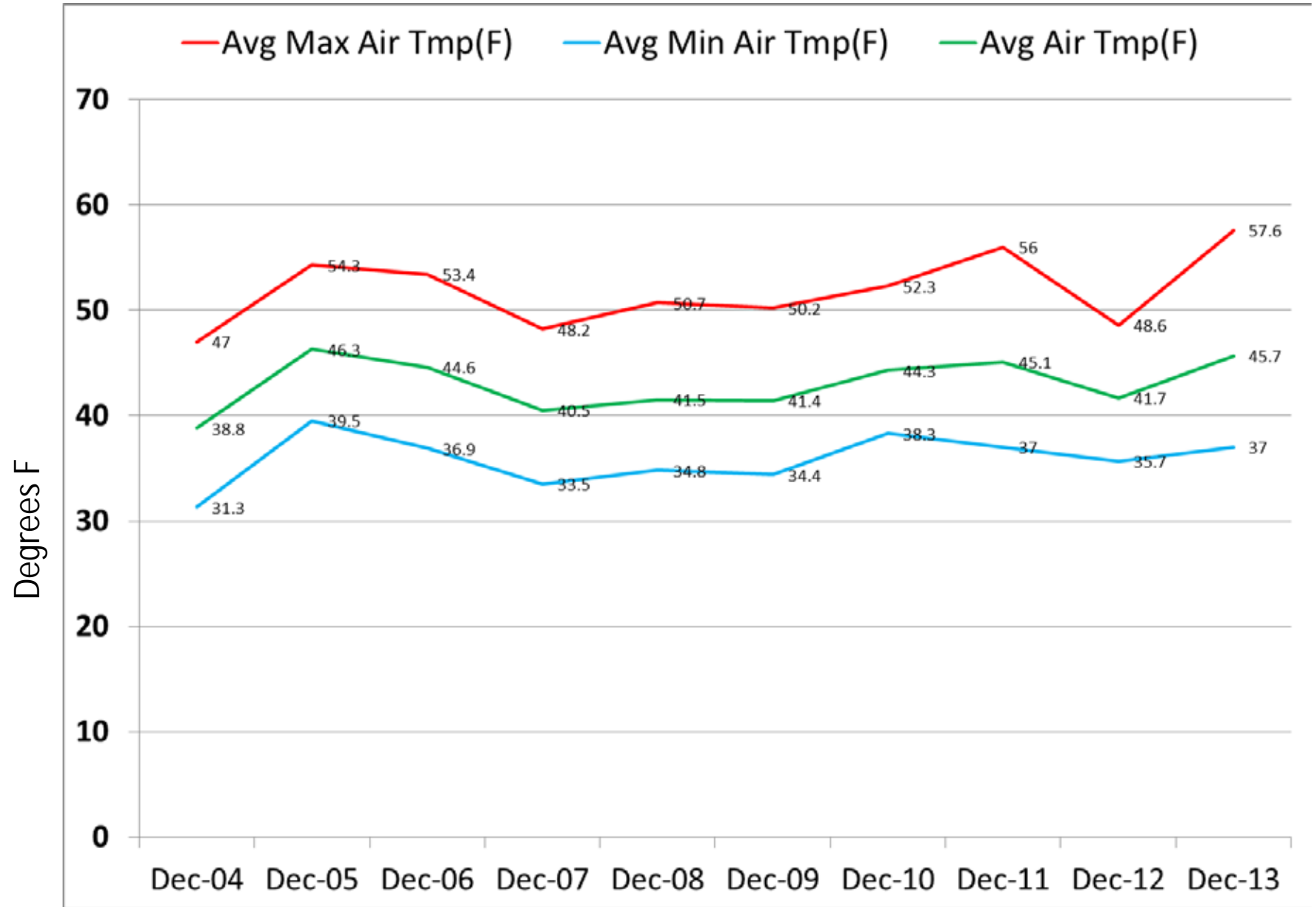
- Irrigation Resources:**

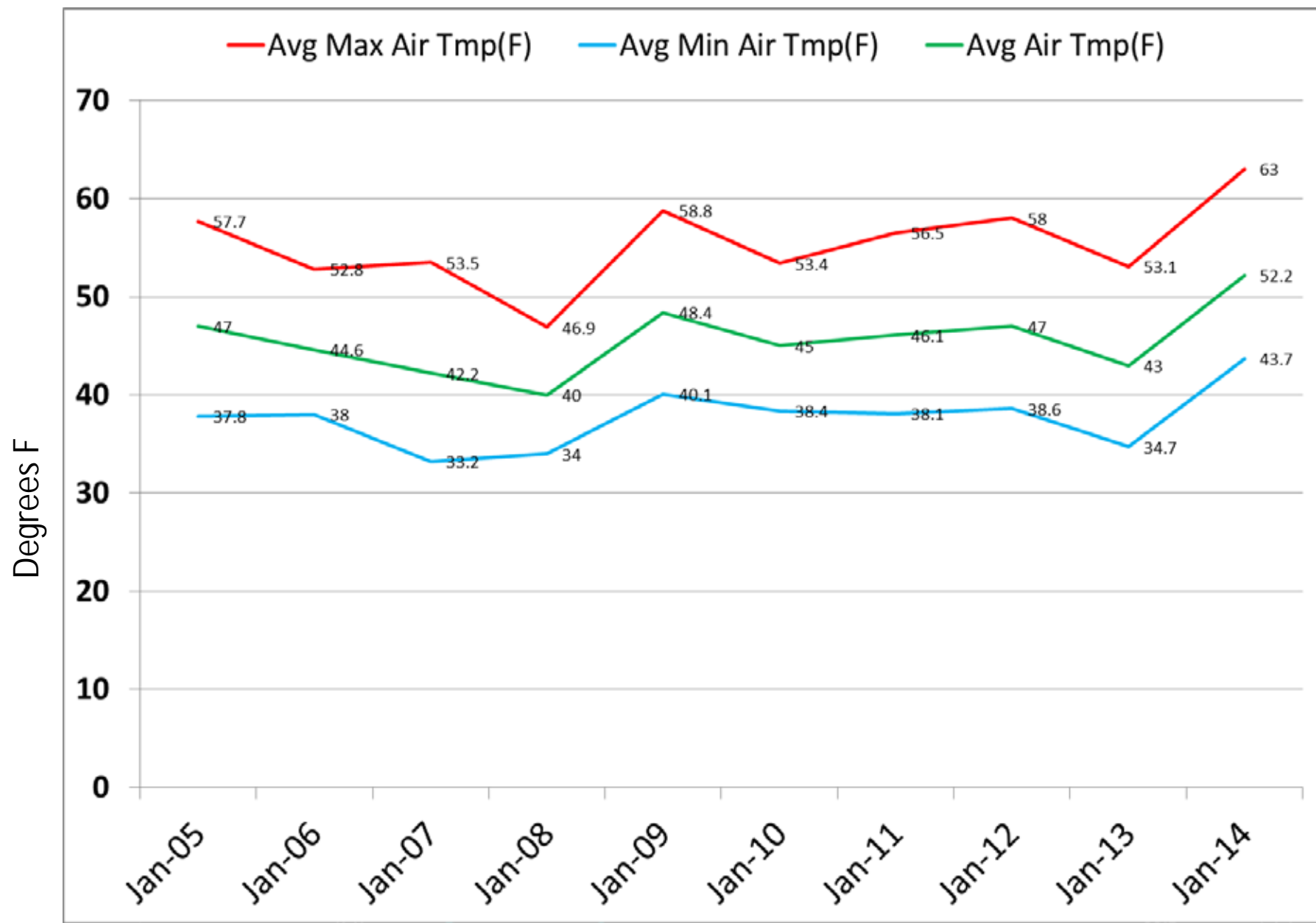
Cumulative Chilling Hours - Station #13 Camino - Nov 1 2013 - Feb 17 2014



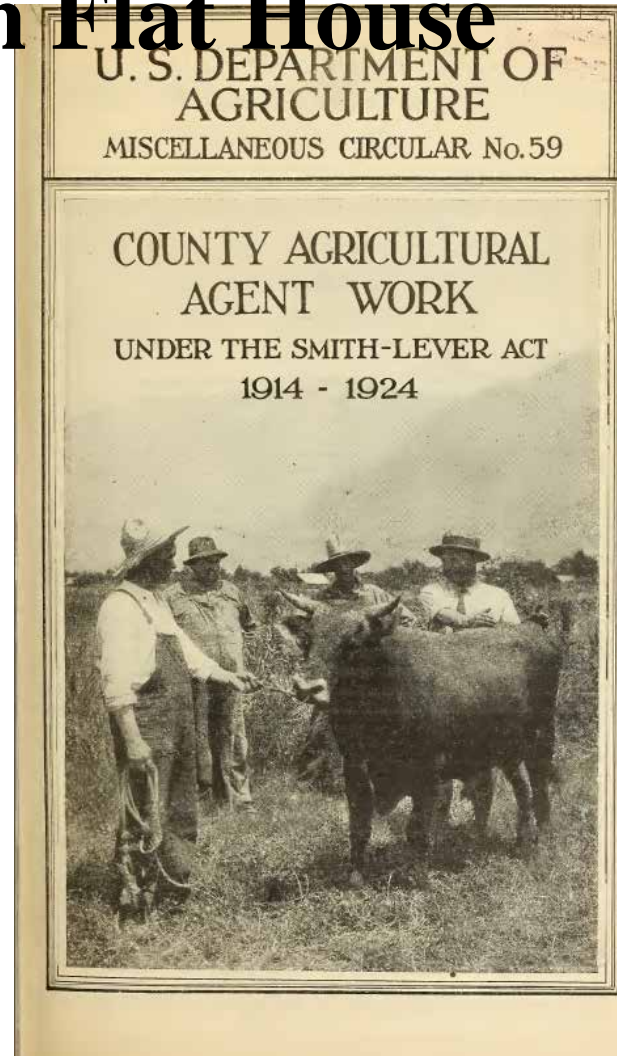
Average Max, Min, and Air Temperatures in December for the Past 10 Years (Camino CIMIS)
